### **Educational Matters**

Forbairt: Fiona O' Regan, Eva O' Sullivan and the Senior Management Team have commenced the Forbairt project in the area of success criteria (linked to learning outcomes). Success criteria set expectations for students, allow students to extend themselves and facilitate teachers in ascertaining how well students have understood and managed the learning intentions. A number of days training took place and a meeting with an advisor in relation to same took place in early November. Teachers who will be involved in the project will upskill in the coming weeks; a presurvey will take place prior to the Christmas exams., success criteria will be introduced to certain classes for a 4–6-week period in January/February, focus groups and teacher discussions will then take place to determine the success of the project and if successful, it will be disseminated to all staff. The Forbairt group will be involved in an Active Learning Community with 4-5 other schools in November to share ideas.
