**All transfer applications to the ASD Support Class, First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth or Sixth Year Group in Carrigtwohill Community College will only be accepted after the 01 March 2024 and the closing date for receipt of transfer applications is 01 April 2024. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.**

<b>Successful applicants to the First Year Group must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission to Carrigtwohill Community College by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:</b>	27 November 2023
